

Exposure of Extr@ videos as a semi-authentic material with Blended Learning

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- I. Objectives:
 - a. Student will be exposed to a segment of an episode at least 5 times.
 - b. Student will be able to comprehend 85% or more of each segment of 2-3 episodes.
 - c. Student will be able to answer “wh” questions verbally about the segments in complete sentences.
 - d. Student will be able to summarize the segment with basic vocabulary verbally and in writing.
 - e. Student will describe characters verbally and in writing.
 - f. Student will summarize episode verbally and in writing.
- II. Procedures
 - a. Student will see a [segment of an episode](#) with no subtitles.
 - b. Student will be given a transcript of episode.
 - c. Student will write footnotes on transcript from the teacher.
 - d. Student will watch episode 2nd time.
 - e. Student will answer “wh” questions in short answer with segment’s [Quizlet set](#).
 - f. Student will hear complete suggested answers of “wh” questions on a Quizlet set.
 - g. Student will watch episode’s segment a 3rd time.
 - h. Student will answer “wh” questions in complete sentence with segment’s Quizlet set.
 - i. Student will watch episode at home with the segment’s [Educanon bulb](#). Students will answer comprehension questions on the segment’s Educanon bulb (4th time exposed).
 - j. Student will see segment a 5th time and describe characters and events.
 - k. Student will answer more of segment’s “wh” questions on a Quizlet set.
 - l. Student will demonstrate timed reading comprehension of questions on a [Kahoot](#) in a competitive environment with peers.
 - m. Student will watch the segment for a 6th time and take a mini quiz assessment online (similar to Google Docs-part of our school website-Whipple Hill)
 - n. Student will summarize the segment verbally or on a screen recording.
- III. Time frame
 - a. Entire school year (whenever there is “extr@ time”, for those who do flipped classroom, for example.)
 - i. Segment is 2-4 minutes
 - ii. 1 segment per week and a half
 - iii. 5-7 segments per episode

- iv. 1.5 episodes per semester
 - v. 3 episodes per year
- IV. Evaluation per segment or episode
 - a. Oral performance on “wh” questions
 - b. Educanon
 - c. Kahoot
 - d. School website mini quiz assessment
 - e. Verbal summary
 - f. Written summary
