



2023 SCOLT Program Cover Contest

The SCOLT Program Cover Contest is an opportunity for K-12 students to demonstrate their artistic abilities and have their work featured as the cover art of the conference program. Download this form to complete and submit an entry.

Contest Details

1. Entry deadline: January 15. Late entries will not be considered for judging.
2. The student must be enrolled in a world language class during the 2022-2023 academic year. The sponsoring world language teacher must be a current paid member of his/her respective state association.
3. A teacher may submit a maximum of three (3) drawings.
4. One drawing will be selected as the 2023 SCOLT Program Cover. The artist will receive a \$50 check and the sponsoring teacher will receive a one-year complimentary SCOLT Sponsor/Patron membership.
5. Entries will be judged on creativity, originality, neatness, and visual impact.
6. All entries will become the property of SCOLT.
7. By entering this contest, the winning student gives SCOLT permission to use his/her entry in any format, including but not limited to the 2023 Conference Program, the SCOLT website, the SCOLT Facebook page, and any social media formats. Further, SCOLT will also include the name of the school and the teacher in conjunction with each appearance of the winning entry.

Artwork Specifications

8. Each drawing must be created by only one student, a drawing by multiple students will not be considered.
9. All entries must be 8 ½” by 11” in size and prepared on a white background. The surface must be flat with no moving parts or additions.
10. The design should be in color.
11. The art can be done in markers, paint or digital drawing. Please do not use charcoal, glitter or tape on the front of the drawing (i.e. no mixed media submissions).
12. Only original artwork may be submitted. No copyrighted figures or photocopied designs may be used.
13. The theme “MOBILize for Language Learning” must be prominently featured in the work (exact wording). Other words are permitted in any language.

How to enter the contest
